2008 K SYRAH “MOTOR CITY KITTY”—WASHINGTON STATE \$35

The 2008 vintage ROCKS! This is a huge, black, dense, dark, complex wine that represents everything I love about Washington Syrah. This is a single vineyard Syrah, aged 24 months in barrel. Very limited quantity!

2008 K SYRAH “PHEASANT VINEYARD”—WAHLUKE SLOPE \$35

Sun-drenched ripe black fruit, wet stone, baking spice and grilled meat.

2008 K SYRAH “NORTHRIDGE”—WAHLUKE SLOPE \$35

Extremely concentrated, intense color. Notes of huckleberry, cedar, cigar and kirsch. Built like a brick sh*t-house; exuberant ripe fruit with grippy backbone and spice with a seamless finish. *(2007 vintage 96pts Wine Spectator)*

2008 K SYRAH “MORRISON LANE”—WALLA WALLA VALLEY \$45

Black fruit, black earth and undergrowth, luxurious texture.

2008 K “THE CREATOR”—WASHINGTON STATE \$50

64% Cabernet, 36% Syrah; The nose offers olives, cloves, meat, game, wild blueberry, and blackberry. This is followed by a powerful yet elegant wine with great density and richness, loads of spice, and a super-long finish. *(2007 vintage 94pts Wine Spectator)*

2008 K “ROMA” EN CHAMBERLIN—WALLA WALLA VALLEY \$60

62% Cabernet, 38% Syrah; Rich and focused, it delivers super complex flavors and long smooth texture. Black currants, pipe tobacco, cool stone, more than ample flavor.

2008 K “OVIDE” EN CERISE—WALLA WALLA VALLEY \$60

67% Cabernet, 33% Syrah; Cedar, black olive and earth. Pure and finesse-full, this wine keeps giving and giving and giving.

2008 K SYRAH “PHIL LANE”—WALLA WALLA VALLEY \$70

Huge violet, boysenberry, lavender, campfire, smoked meat, cold stone. This oozes flavor proving that big things DO come in small packages. From our estate vineyard.

2008 EVE CHARDONNAY—COLUMBIA VALLEY \$12

Sinfully tempting...fresh, crisp, the perfume of sweet apple blossoms lures you into The Garden of Eden. Silky, soft, mouth-filling deliciousness...*take the first sip!*

2009 THE VELVET DEVIL MERLOT—COLUMBIA VALLEY \$12

PURE VELVET! Milk chocolate, wild blackberry, baking spice, rose oil...beautifully perfumed Washington in a glass....Velvet Devil? *HELL YEAH!*

2007 CHATEAU SMITH CABERNET—COLUMBIA VALLEY \$20

Delicious! Aromatics galore—cigar box, pencil lead, cedar and currants with super refined tannins and a long, fine finish. French? No. Chateau Smith? *OUI!*

2007 HEART—ROYAL SLOPE \$120

98 Pts Robert Parker, The Wine Advocate *“Sourced from Stoneridge Vineyard it was aged entirely in neutral oak. Earth, underbrush, truffle, brier, game, bacon, and blueberry aromas lead to loaded, super-rich, unctuous, full-bodied Syrah. Mouth-filling, complex, and multi-dimensional, it has exceptional length and impeccable balance. Give it 3-4 years to become a bit more civilized, enjoy from 2014 to 2027.”*

2007 SKULL—ROYAL SLOPE \$120

98 Pts Robert Parker, The Wine Advocate *“From Stoneridge Vineyard on the Royal Slope, it was aged in 20% new oak with some stems. It is a more brooding effort with aromas of earth, underbrush, truffle, Asian spices, incense, and blueberry. It is slightly more structured with a bit more density and richness. Give it 6-8 years of additional bottle age and drink 2017 to 2032.”*
