Fruit-forward, spicy and appealing, this is consistent with previous editions of this popular wine. Since 2005 is a particularly good year, this has more concentration and fruit power than usual. I particularly like the tight blackberry core, wrapped in leaf and showing a lot of earthy flavors. The 30% new oak is folded into the wine, not dominant, and it finished with good focus, purity and balance. (2005 Vintage)

Score: 87 Points

Good dark ruby-red. Sexy nose offers brown spices, garrigue, bacon fat and woodsmoke. Thick but firm, showing more nutty and saline elements than primary fruit. The saline character carries through on the firmly tannic finish. (2005 Vintage)

Vineyards:

Sundance – This vineyard has a slight northerly slope which lends it to be a cooler site in a very warm growing region. Slopes are 18 inches of sandy loam over a deep layer of coarse dark gray sand providing good soil drainage.

Pheasant – Less than two miles from Sundance, this vineyard has a very similar soil composition to Sundance but its aspect ;makes all the difference. Pheasant ripens earlier, adding full, mature fruit flavors to this Wahluke Slope Syrah.
