



## **2006 K “The Deal” — Wahluke Slope 100% Sundance Vineyard Syrah**

**Tasting Notes:** Pure, single vineyard syrah from the Wahluke Slope. Foot crushed, basket pressed— rich, tasty, a fine, fine Syrah.—*Charles Smith*

**Score: 93 (2006 Vintage) Wine Spectator**

*“Rich, ripe and distinctive for the tarry, smoky dark chocolate and black olive character that weaves through blackberry and ripe cherry fruit, all of it mingling on the solid, well-formed finish. Best from 2011 through 2016.”*

**Score: 94 (2005 Vintage) The Wine Advocate**

*“Fragrant nose of mineral, scorched earth, game, espresso, blueberry, and blackberry. Opulent on the palate, rich, and full-flavored, the wine has gobs of spicy fruit leading to a lengthy, fruit-filled finish. Give it 2-3 years to evolve, and drink through 2018”*

**Vineyards:**

**100% Sundance vineyard**—located on the Wahluke Slope. Sundance has a slight northerly slope which lends to a cooler site: in a very warm growing region. Slopes are 18 inches of sandy loam over a deep layer of coarse dark gray sand—providing good soil drainage. Planted in 1997
