



**2008 K “Guido” — Walla Walla Valley  
100% Sangiovese**

**Tasting Notes**

Only two 500 liter barrels of this single vineyard beauty. From “the rocks” and farmed by Jack, this wine shows tobacco, tiny Italian cherries, leather, and anise. With tannins a plenty this wine is sure to please. Capeche?! —*Charles Smith*

**Vineyards**

**Lefore Vineyard:** Stony, ancient riverbed, located on the floor of the Walla Walla Valley. This vineyard is 80% Sangiovese and 20% Syrah. Very cobbly, Freewater loam - cobbles over gravel over sand, dried riverbed. In the rocky soils of this part of the Valley, low vigor keeps flavors concentrated. Planted in 1999.

**Elevage**

The fruit for the 2008 Guido was hand-picked, with yields at about 2.4 tons to the acre. Like all K wines, the fruit was foot crushed, fermented with only native yeasts, manually punched down, basket-pressed, and aged in French oak, about 20% new, Bordeaux barrels (cooperages included Radoux and Taransaud). The tannic structure of this wine should allow for graceful ageing.
